

## **New Editor of the Journal of Architectural Engineering**

Following Professor Kevin Parfitt's decision to step down from the position of Editor of the Journal of Architectural Engineering, the AEI Board of Governors has appointed Paul Seaburg, Ph.D., P.E. to that position. Dr. Paul Seaburg, currently on the civil engineering faculty of the Missouri University of Science and Technology, has agreed to take on this important responsibility.

Dr. Seaburg obtained his BS and M.S. in civil engineering at the University of Minnesota and his Ph.D. in civil engineering at the University of Wisconsin. For many years, Dr. Seaburg served as Department Head and Professor in the Department of Architectural Engineering at Penn State University, before becoming Associate Dean, College of Engineering & Technology, University of Nebraska-Lincoln (Omaha campus). He then served as Dean and Dean Emeritus of the School of Engineering, Southern Illinois University Edwardsville.

Dr. Seaburg was awarded five U.S. patents. He is a professional engineer registered in Ohio, Pennsylvania, and Wisconsin. He has been active in committees of ASCE, the American Society for Engineering Education, the National Society of Professional Engineers, the Society of American Military Engineers and the National Institute of Building Sciences.

He has served on the Executive Committee of the ASCE Structural Division and the first Executive Committee of the Architectural Engineering Division (AED) and was instrumental in establishing AEI. Most recently, he served as Chair of the AEI Standards Administrative Committee and on the ASCE Codes and Standards Committee.
